



## eLearning at SSHIPS

### What is eLearning (eLearn)?

At present, Southport State High has over 230 courses across the schooling areas.

Each student is enrolled in a specific course for each of their scheduled classes on our LMS, eLearn.

Each course is a private virtual classroom; a secure platform for online teaching and learning. This takes place on eLearn ([elearn.eq.edu.au](http://elearn.eq.edu.au)), where students will logon, using their current EQ username and password.

### What do our courses consist of:

- Lesson activities and Units of Work
- Homework
- Online formative and summative assessments
- Collaborative projects
- Discussion and feedback

Each learning content area is broken into three sections, with descriptions below:

- 1) Learning Intention and Success Criteria
- 2) Get Ready
- 3) Must Do
- 4) Give Me More

#### Learning Intention and Success Criteria:

Learning Intentions are descriptions of what learners should know, understand and be able to do by the end of a learning period or unit.

Success Criteria are the measures used to determine whether, and how well, learners have met the learning intentions.

#### 'Get Ready' Section:

During the 'Get Ready' phase, students are preparing to learn. To do this, they will engage with a 'Get Ready' activity to build their understanding of core lesson content, activate prior knowledge or connect with the curriculum.

#### 'Must Do' Section:

The 'Must Do' learning experiences are ones that all students are expected to engage with, to meet key learning outcomes. As a learner at Southport State High, students need to complete the tasks in this section.

#### 'Give Me More' Section:

The 'Give Me More' learning experiences are extension activities designed to help students extend and improve their knowledge and skills. As a learner, students should engage with these resources when they have completed the 'Must Do' activities, or as directed by their teacher.

eLearn is best accessed on a web browser and we do not support the use of blackboard apps.
