

Audition and Art Portfolio Guidelines

Dance

Perform two (2) solo items of your choice in contrasting genres, maximum 1minute per routine. For example, jazz and hip hop. Pleas refer to the examples below:

Style A – Hip Hop

Style A – Jazz

Style B – Contemporary

Style B – Lyrical

<u>Drama</u>

Perform one (1) monologue. If desired, props or costumes may be used. Please select one monologue from the examples below:

Monologues

Music (Apply for either Vocal OR Instrumental)

Vocal – Two (2) short song excerpts of the student's choice that best represent the student's level of ability (maximum 1minute per song).

Instrumental – Two (2) contrasting pieces of repertoire of the student's choice that best represent the student's level of ability (maximum 1minute per piece) as well as two (2) scales.

Theory – You will be given access to a short theory exam which is to be submitted along with your audition video for your chosen discipline (either vocal or instrumental).
