Southport State High

What do you need to do?

- Upload a digital portfolio to a link which will be provided by the Excellence Coordinator.
- Once entered, you must maintain an *excellent effort* rating and above a *B for academic achievement*



Preparing your portfolio:

- Compile your artwork
- Showcase only your best artwork
- Include observational drawings
- Artist statements to explain reasoning behind your work
- Have a friend or family member look over your art

Assembling your portfolio:

- Take photos of your artworks/sculptures. Ensure your photos are clear, well lit and free from shadows
- Group similar artworks together
- Keep your portfolio simple
- Write an artist statement for one of your artworks and explain why you have created the art piece and justify your choices through the artistic process



Portfolio Requirements:

Depending on your style you may like to include:

- Paintings
- Drawings
- Printmaking
- Jewellery
- Fashion design

- 3D models
- Digital Illustration
- Visual Diaries
- If you have large works/sculptures include a full-size image and a detailed image
